1. Introduction

ISKALI (“we,” “us,” “our,” or “ISKALI”) is committed to respecting your privacy and safeguarding your personal information. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect information when you visit our website (the “Site”), interact with us online or offline, participate in community activities, or engage with our programs.

By accessing or using the Site or communicating with us, you agree to the terms of this Policy.

2. Information We Collect

A. Information You Provide to Us

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you:

- Subscribe to newsletters
- Complete contact, registration, or participation forms
- Make donations
- Communicate with us by email, phone, or messaging
- Register for events, programs, retreats, or community gatherings

Types of personal information we collect may include:

- Full name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Mailing address
- Date of birth (if relevant to a program)
- Demographic information (e.g., language preference)
- Participation details for programs or events
- Donation and payment details



We do not collect more personal information than is necessary for the legitimate purposes described here.

If you register for a retreat or program, we may collect information necessary for administrative, logistical, or safety purposes.

B. Information Collected Automatically

When you visit our Site, we may automatically collect certain information through cookies and similar technologies, including:

- IP address
- Device type
- Browser type and version
- Pages visited and time spent
- Referring links or websites
- Interaction data and usage patterns

This information helps us analyze trends, administer the Site, improve user experience, and enhance security.

3. How We Use Information

We may use your personal information to:

- Provide and administer programs, events, and services
- Communicate with you about activities, updates, newsletters, and opportunities
- Facilitate donations and provide acknowledgment
- Respond to your questions, feedback, or requests
- Manage and improve our Site and digital services
- Conduct analytics and research to better serve our community
- Protect against fraud, abuse, and security risks

We will not sell your personal information to third parties.



4. Donations and Payment Processing

When you make a donation through the Site, your contribution is processed securely by a third-party payment processor. We do not store complete payment card numbers on our servers.

Third-party processors may collect, store, and process your payment information in accordance with their own privacy and security practices.

5. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files placed on your device when you visit a website.

How We Use Cookies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- Enable essential site functionality
- Remember visitor preferences
- Understand Site usage and improve performance
- Provide personalized content

We may use third-party analytics tools (e.g., analytics services) to understand how visitors engage with our Site.

Your Choices

You can control or delete cookies through your browser settings. If you disable cookies, certain features of the Site may not function properly.

6. Sharing of Information

We do not sell, trade, or rent your personal information to third parties.



We may share information with:

- Service providers under contract who help operate our Site or perform functions on our behalf (e.g., email service providers, analytics vendors)
- Program coordinators, when necessary, to administer events or community activities
- Legal authorities, if required by law or to protect legal rights or safety
- Other organizations, only with your consent

These service providers are authorized to use and disclose your information only as necessary to perform services for us.

7. Your Privacy Choices

Depending on how you interact with us, you may have rights regarding your information, including:

- Request access to the personal information we hold about you
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Ask us to delete personal information
- Opt out of certain communications

8. Children's Privacy

Our Site and programs are not directed to children under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13 without verifiable parental consent.

If we learn that we have collected personal information from a child under 13 without appropriate consent, we will take steps to delete that information as soon as possible.

9. Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect personal information against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or alteration.



However, no method of transmission over the Internet or electronic storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

10. Third-Party Links

The Site may contain links to third-party websites, applications, or services that are not operated by ISKALI. We are not responsible for the content, privacy practices, or policies of such third parties. We encourage users to review the privacy policies of any third-party site they visit.

11. Retention of Personal Information

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Policy, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.
